

What is a pet passport?

A pet passport is a passport for dogs, cats and ferrets that travel or are to be moved between Member states of the EU, the EEA and Switzerland.

When do I need a pet passport?

A pet passport is needed for all dogs, cats or ferrets that travel or are to be moved between Member states of the EU, the EEA and Switzerland.

Where do I get a pet passport?

A pet passport is available from any veterinary practitioner resident in Austria or at the University of Veterinary Medicine. The passport and the issue thereof are liable to costs.

Is there an old and a new pet passport?

Since 29 December 2014 there is a new pet passport available. If you already have a pet passport for your animal this passport remains valid for the animal's lifetime.
